Former Nit Noi employees in Houston and the Woodlands can opt to join lawsuit: Notice to join filed for the worker's group seeking back wages for overtime and minimum wage

HOUSTON — Former employees represented by Kennedy Hodges LLP have filed a court action allowing other workers to join the suit to recover back minimum wage and overtime pay. The filing enables other workers to assert their rights to recover unpaid overtime wages due under the Fair Labor Standards Act.

Kennedy Hodges LLP estimates that hundreds of individuals may have been victims of Nit Noi's federal wage law violations. The plaintiffs brought the action on behalf of themselves and others who during the past three years were employed by **Nit Noi** as waiters, busboys, food runners, servers, or kitchen staff.

Plaintiffs' attorney Galvin Kennedy stated, "Restaurants are notorious for these types of wage violations and low-wage restaurant employees are especially at risk."

The original filing states that Nit Noi violated the federal Fair Labor Standards Act by not compensating kitchen employees as required by federal minimum wage laws, and the lawsuit alleges that Nit Noi violated the tip pooling act. The lawsuit was filed against all of Nit Noi's Houston and Woodlands locations
